Scrappy Wreath Bow



Knitting Pattern

About the Pattern

Yarn

- Three strands of fingering weight, 9g each
- Two strands of lace weight mohair/silk, 5g each
- Sample shown in three strands of Knit Picks Palette (fingering weight; 100% Peruvian highland wool; 231yd / 50g) and two strands of Hobbii Friends Kid Silk (lace weight, 72% mohair, 25% silk, 3% wool; 219yd / 25g).
- All five strands of yarn are held together in this pattern

Needles

- US 11 (8mm) needles, or size to obtain gauge

Notions

- Yarn needle
- Removable stitch marker
- 14"/35cm wreath

Gauge

- 14 sts and 20 rows = 4" / 10cm in Stockinette st in the round, blocked

Finished Measurements

- 7"/17.5cm wide and 8"/20cm high

Pattern Notes

This wreath bow is knit flat in garter stitch with a slipped stitch edge. The sample uses five strands of yarn held together, but any combination of yarn adding up to a bulky weight will work.

Abbreviations

CO: Cast on.

K: Knit.

K2tog: Knit two together.

M1L: Make one left. Lift the strand between stitches from the front onto the left needle and knit through the back loop.

M1R: Make one right. Lift the strand between stitches from the back onto the left needle and knit through the front loop.

RS: Right side.

SI: Slip stitch purlwise.

Ssk: Slip, slip, knit.

St(s): Stitch(es).

Wyif: With yarn in front.

WS: Wrong side.

Pattern Instructions

CO 3 sts using long-tail CO.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): Sl1 wyif, m1R, k1, m1L, sl1 wyif. (5 sts).

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: Sl1 wyif, m1R, k3, m1L, sl1 wyif. (7 sts).

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: Sl1 wyif, m1R, k5, m1L, sl1 wyif. (9 sts).

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Sl1 wyif, knit to last st, sl1 wyif.

Repeat Rows 7–8 for 27"/67.5cm.

Row 9: Knit.

Row 10: Sl1 wyif, k2tog, k3, ssk, sl1 wyif. (7 sts).

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Sl1 wyif, k2tog, k1, ssk, sl1 wyif. (5 sts).

Row 9: Knit.

Row 10: K2tog, k1, ssk. (3 sts).

Row 11: K3tog. (1 st).

Cut yarn and draw through remaining st. Weave in ends.

Fold into a bow shape and using the last of the yarn to wrap around the center of the bow and secure. Use that scrap yarn to firmly attach to a wreath frame or finished wreath.
